Global Impact Leadership Academy uses a proprietary LMS that allows schools, parents, and staff to monitor student performance and achievement.

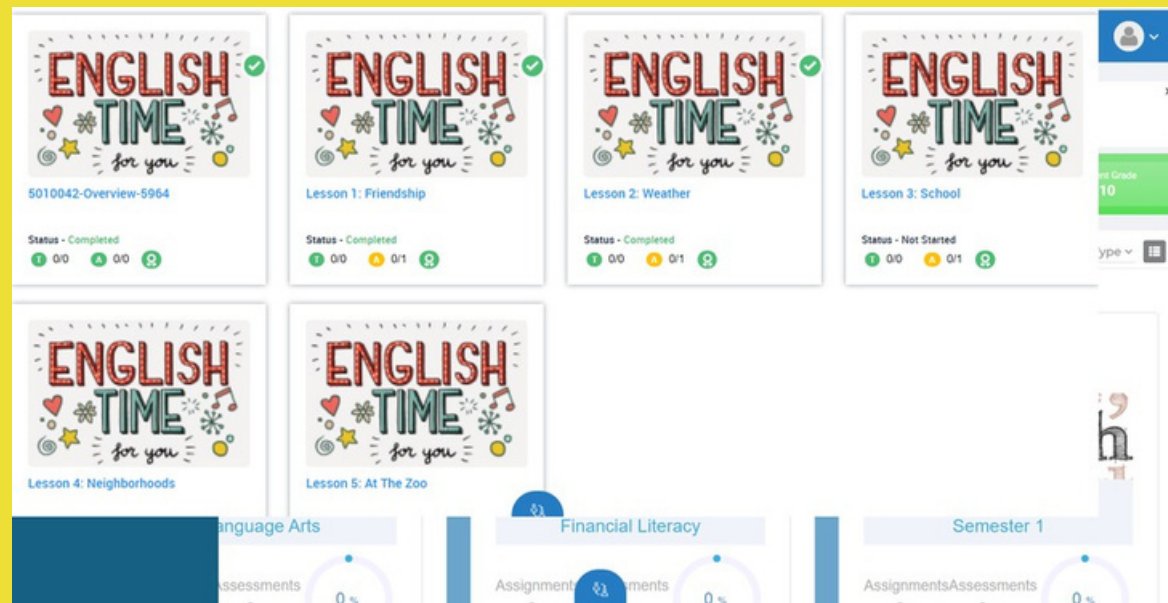
All parents will have access to monitor their children. All school partners will have access to monitor their students.

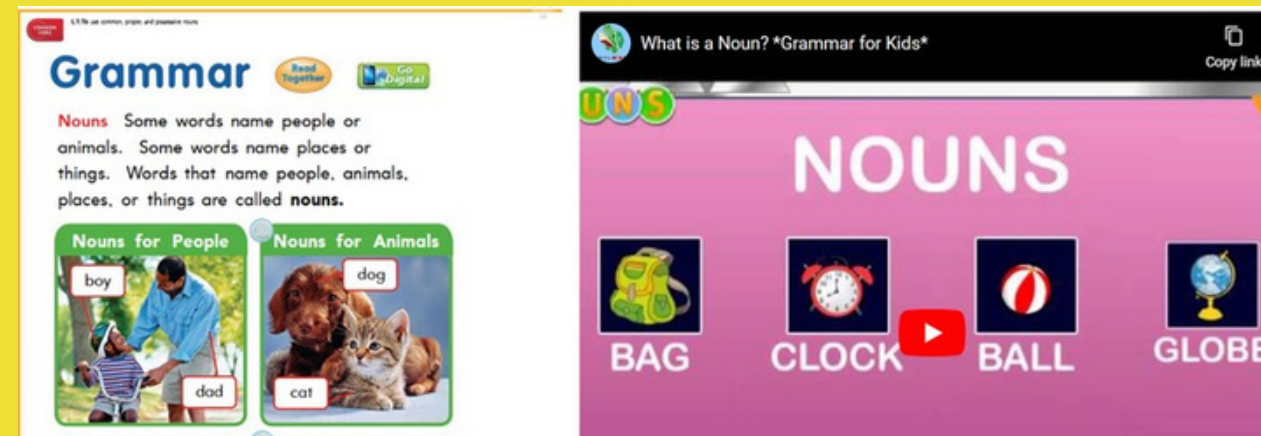

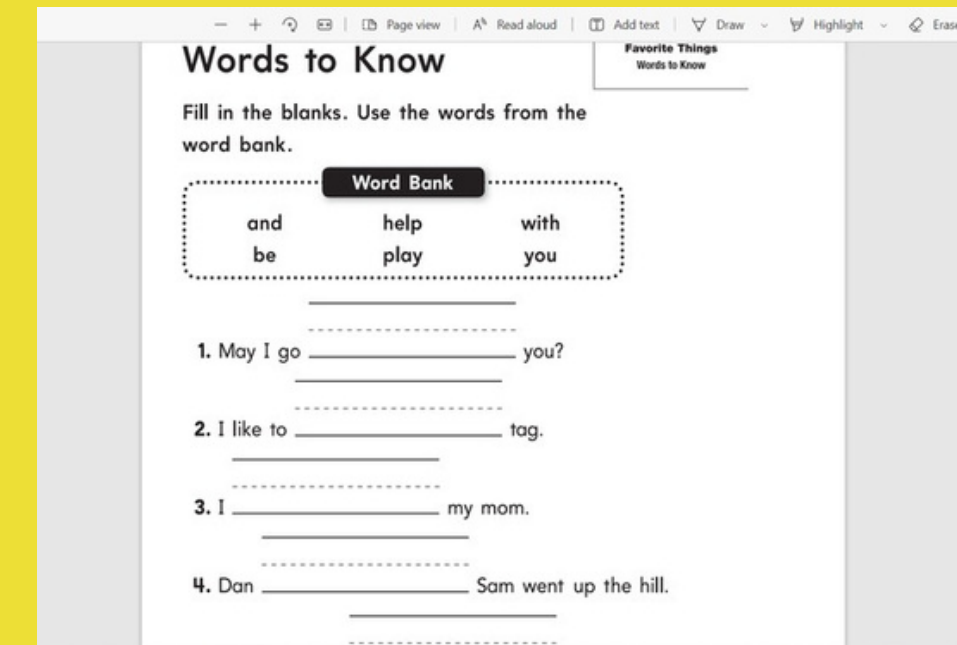
Elementary School- All courses follow a user friendly format making it easy for students to navigate between lessons.

One-Step Equations and Properties of Equality: Additive Inverse

The additive inverse of a number is another number that, when added to the original, equals zero. Using the additive inverse can be helpful when trying to solve equations.

- Move the red point across the number line to change the value in red.
- The value in the blue is the additive inverse of the value in red.

When solving a one-step equation, if the value in red is being added, add the value in blue.

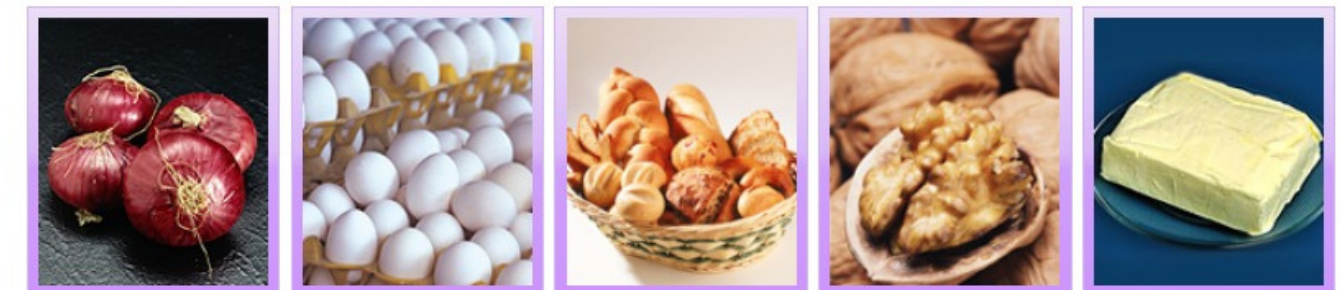
